I. CLUB ACTIONS

- Serve exclusively plant-based meals at least once per month
- Have a vegan option on your menu and choose seasonal options
- Carpool to meetings or explore public transport options
- Serve food and drink in reusable containers
- Improve climate awareness with speakers and projects

2. VENUE ACTIONS

Speak to your venue about making these climate clever changes

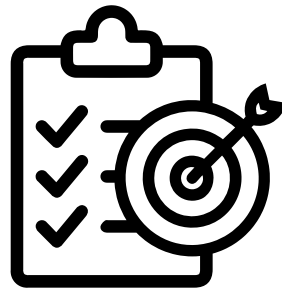
- Separate your waste and recycle glass, plastic, paper etc.
- Switch to a more renewable energy provider such as Ecotricity or Octopus Energy.
- Set your thermostat to between 18 and 20 degrees Celsius and turn off any radiators not required.
- Change your light bulbs to energy efficient light bulbs.
- Always turn lights and electrical equipment off when not being used.
- Wear jumpers or coats before turning on the heating
